Gentlemen:

Realizing that the condition of the County Funds will not permit the Court to pay for the services of a part time Home Demonstration Agent and believing that the County should have such an agent at this time to see that food for the coming year is canned and provided to the best advantages, the Chamber of Commerce, in Session on Friday Nite, March 20th, voted to pay the Counties part of the salary for the agent, which amount will be (\$500.00) for the year. The Chamber of Commerce respectfully petitions the Court to pass the order for the appropriation of the above amount and so notify the Extension Service Authorities and the Chamber of Commerce will pay to the County Funds the sum of \$41.66 monthly to be used as the part paid by the County on the salary of the above mentioned agent.
