



UPSHUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

March 7, 1983

Commissioners Court met in Special Session with all members present.

Judge Dean read the minutes of the February 28, 1983 meeting. Motion was made by Commissioner Delmo Lawson seconded by Commissioner J. W. Meadows for the minutes to stand as read. Motion carried.

Motion was made by J. W. Meadows seconded by Paul Davis to approve the Deputation of Jack Hoffpauir and David Harrel Chrisp as Reserve Deputy Sheriff's. Motion carried. Copies attached.

Sheriff Dale Jewkes met with the Court asking that he be allowed to send a representative to the Texas Corrections Association meeting in Huntsville, Texas March 23-25, 1983. He also suggested that someone from the Court attend. Motion was made by Charles Still seconded by Delmo Lawson for the Sheriff, or his representative, be allowed to attend, and anyone from the Court who wants to go. Motion carried.

Sheriff Dale Jewkes gave a statistical report on his office for the past year.

Motion by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to approve payment of a ROW Deed on Hwy. 300 from Ray Wedgeworth. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Delmo Lawson to allow the Boy Scouts use of the Courthouse lawn April 7, 1983. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Delmo Lawson to give Judge Dean the authority to sign a contract on the purchase of land for the jail when some is found. Motion carried.

Motion by Paul Davis seconded by J. W. Meadows to allow the Pritchett Fire Department loading dock to be graveled. Motion carried.

Commissioner Charles Still suggested that the Court look into some of the various types of asphalt material, and consider covering some of the most heavily traveled County Roads with some type of asphalt surface.

Judge Dean read a letter from Ann Goar, in the District Clerk's Office, expressing her appreciation to the Court for allowing her to attend the "11th Annual County and District Clerks' Seminar" in College Station. Motion was made by Charles Still seconded by Paul Davis to enter this letter in the Court minutes. Motion carried. Copy attached.

Motion by Delmo Lawson seconded by J. W. Meadows to inquire into buying a desk for Justice of the Peace in Diana. Motion carried.



Motion by Paul Davis seconded by Charles Still to approve the payment of the unpaid bills. Motion carried. Copy attached.






COMMISSIONER, PCT. #1
