
Whereas, under authority conferred by the Library Systems Act, also being known as Article 5446a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, there was established the State Library System; and,

Be it resolved, that the Commissioners Court of Upshur County, Texas, does hereby accept designation as an Area library.


It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the County Judge of Upshur County, Texas, be authorized to sign this order for the Commissioners Court of said County.
