

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A COUNTY TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE FUND GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Upshur County desires to develop a viable community, including safe and dependable transportation routes for residential, commercial and industrial use; and

WHEREAS, the County is in an area affected by oil and gas production; and

WHEREAS, the County has identified county-maintained roads which have suffered damages as a result of energy-sector traffic; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Upshur County to apply for funding under the County Transportation Infrastructure Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF UPSHUR COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a County Transportation Infrastructure Fund application is hereby authorized to be submitted on behalf of the County to the Texas Department of Transportation.
2. That the application be for \$2,053,800 of grant funds to repair roads damaged by energy-sector traffic.
3. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, and real property acquisition requirements.
4. That it further be stated that Upshur County is committing 10% of TxDOT approved total project costs in an amount not to exceed \$228,200 as matching funds for the construction and program management of the approved projects.
